



UK GOVERNMENT DEFINITION

- In a combined report published by the U.K. Home Office and His Majesty's Revenue and Customs (H.M.R.C.), Diverse Suppliers were defined as comprising of one of four sub-sets (Government, 2016):
 - Small and Medium Enterprises (S.M.E.),
 - Black, Asian and Minority Ethnic (B.A.M.E.),
 - Suppliers from other under-represented or protected groups,
 - Suppliers demonstrating a diverse workforce composition.
- Common wording used:
 - Under-represented, Under-recognised, Under-estimated, Marginalized, Under-served,

Diverse Workforce

Suppliers demonstrating a diverse workforce definition does not specify if private or publicly owned business.

Black, Asian & Ethnic Minority (BAME)

- Ethnic minorities with the exclusion of White British.
 - Includes: Black, Asian, Arab, Mixed/Multiple ethnicity, Gypsy, Irish Traveller, Roma, other ethnic groups.
- MSDUK

<u>Under-represented & Protected Groups</u>

- Under-represented: statistical factor related to the number of business owners from a defined demographic.
- Protected Groups protected by legislation that prevents discrimination:
 - Equality Act 2010 age, disability, gender reassignment, being married or in a civil partnership, being pregnant or on maternity leave, race, religion or belief, sex or sexual orientation
 - Armed Forces Act 2011 Veterans
- WeConnect International Female Owned Businesses
- OutBritain LGBTQIA+ Owned Businesses
- Veteran Owned UK Veteran owned Businesses
